OUR VISION: A world where no one is needlessly blind.

THE PROBLEM: The need for eye care in Congo is real, huge and desperate.

170,000 The number of Congolese estimated to suffer from blindness or visual impairment.

3 in 4 who are visually impaired require help with daily activities.

The percentage of Congolese that live in Absolute Poverty, i.e. < USD1 a day

9 out of 10 people who are blind cannot go to work or school.

THE SOLUTION: We have opened the first and only Eye Centre in northern Congo.

Provide Comprehensive Eye Care

4 in 5 blind or visually impaired people in the world are suffering needlessly because their eye conditions are either preventable or treatable.

We provide accessible comprehensive eye care to preserve and restore sight. This includes well-proven measures such as cataract surgery, which are amongst the world's most cost effective health interventions.

Empower the local community

We train and empower the local community to create sustainable, economically viable and locally managed services so that they will continue to serve local populations long after New Sight's involvement is complete.

This includes teaching skills in the areas of medicine and administration, as well as community health education through radio programs and health fairs.


Advocate Eye Health

We partner with the government, health authorities and schools to advocate, raise awareness and provide health education.

We also work in collaboration with international organisations such as Médecin Sans Frontier and United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees who send us their patients.

OUR IMPACT: The priceless gift of sight transforms thousands of lives in one of the poorest and most neglected areas in the world.

When sight is restored the impact is profound, immediate and sustained for at least 6 years*
